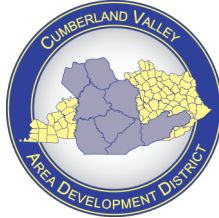

CALL TO ORDER/WELCOME

Ms. Suzie Razmus, Secretary, called the Regional Transportation Committee meeting to order at 10:30 a.m. Quorum was present.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Mr. Marlon Sams moved that the minutes be approved as presented. Mr. Mike Mitchell seconded the motion. Motion carried.

ELECTION OF TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE OFFICERS

Mr. Marlon Sams moved to nominate Judge Executive Shane Gabbard as Chair, Mayor Suzie Razmus as Vice-Chair, and Judge Executive Howell Holbrook as Secretary. Judge Executive Dan Mosley seconded the motion. Nominations were accepted and approved unanimously.

TRANSPORTATION UPDATES

Ms. Jessica Blankenship presented the Recommended Highway Plan as presented by Governor Andy Beshear. She noted that she has discussed the top priorities per county with each Legislator. Senator Johnnie Turner indicated that the US-421 project in Harlan County from the VA State Line to Barn Branch would most definitely be completed in the next highway plan. This project has been in the plan for over 20 years.

Ms. Blankenship provided information on how to obtain data from KY Transportation Cabinet's DataMart website. She also provided updates on the SPAN Grants received for Bike/Pedestrian Planning. Bicycle & Pedestrian Master Plans are being worked on for the cities of McKee and Mt. Vernon. A feasibility study is being conducted in Manchester for a multi-use path to connect the Riverwalk to the hospital. A feasibility study was completed in Williamsburg and Corbin for projects. Ms. Blankenship indicated that NADO has utilized her City of Corbin Bicycle & Pedestrian Master Plan as a template and a case study in planning. The city was one of 3 in Kentucky and 1 of a few in the US to be chosen to be in the case study.

Ms. Blankenship presented the CEDS Plan Transportation Update section, identifying the SWOT analysis of the CVADD Area. No committee members had any additional input.

Ms. Blankenship presented information on the Section 5304 Rural Public Transit Grant. Through the Section 5304 Public Transportation Program, CVADD staff provides technical assistance to area public transportation providers. This effort includes helping in obtaining financial aid, communicating new policies, procedures, and legislative requirements to providers, and coordination between agencies when necessary. Public Transportation can be used for shopping, medical appointments, pharmacy, education, employment, training, or other matters.

Ms. Blankenship provided information on the Infrastructure Investment Jobs Act grant information.

KYTC PROJECT UPDATES

Mr. Jeff Dick provided updates on Rockcastle County projects. Mr. Keenan Jones provided updates on HDO District 11 projects. Mr. Kenny Morgan and Mr. Jacob Huber were not present for Central Office updates.

OTHER BUSINESS

No other business was brought before the committee.

ADJOURNMENT

Mr. Shane Gabbard moved to adjourn the meeting. Mr. Dan Mosley seconded the motion. Motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 11:00 a.m.
